

MOTION TO REDACT ORDER

Respondent now comes before this court in reference to an associated case, Cleveland Metropolitan Bar Association, interim remedial Suspension, Case Number 2011-2110. Following this Court's decision, documents were placed on this Court's public website. These documents reference highly detailed medical information. This information concerns respondent's psychiatric hospitalization and ongoing substance abuse treatment. The suspension was not contested. The information contained in the Court's order goes so far as to possibly be a violation of Respondent's right to privacy as found in the Health Insurance Portability and Privacy Act (HIPPA). To gratuitously advertise an attorney's mental health treatment will have a chilling effect on other attorneys seeking help for their mental health problems and, as this case is being closely followed, it has made respondent an object of ridicule and abuse from his former coworkers. The public can be put on notice of the suspension without the specific information currently available online.

I most respectfully request that the information referenced be pulled from the Court's website, immediately, and that any medical information be redacted.


