NOTICE OF ORAL ARGUMENT

The Supreme Court of Ohio will hold an oral argument on the merits in this case on Wednesday, April 24, 2013, as part of the Logan County off-site court session. Oral arguments will be held at the Bellefontaine High School, 555 East Lake Avenue, Bellefontaine, OH 43311. Time allowed for oral argument will be 15 minutes per side.

Attorneys who argue before the court must comply with the provisions of Rule 17.03 through 17.05 of the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and the instructions that follow. Pursuant to Rule 17.03, counsel for either or both parties may waive oral argument and submit the case upon briefs. The Clerk must be notified in writing of the waiver at least seven days before the date scheduled for the oral argument.

Court convenes promptly at 9 a.m. Counsel in all cases are expected to be present when court convenes. Counsel must register with the Marshal **prior to 8:45 a.m.**
