The names of the members are: Dennis Calhoun Jr., Eric White, Corey Bason, Isaiah Harris, and Kareem Tucker.

**COUNT ONE
(THE CALHOUN CASE)**

FACT – Dennis A. Calhoun Jr. has never stated that King Ayettey Zubaidah has ever acted as his lawyer, or any other form of legal counsel on his behalf.

FACT- May 15th 2012, Mr. Dennis Calhoun Sr. testified that King Ayettey Zubaidah never gave his son Dennis Calhoun Jr. any legal advice or led them to believe that he was acting as their attorney.

By David Nehr on testimony on page 87 #4 Q. by attorney Duff, “**He’s never held himself out as being a lawyer, has he?** Have you ever heard him say that? #7 A. by attorney Nehr, “**Not in my cases**”.

COUNT TWO
ERIC WHITE CASE

FACT – Eric White has never stated that King Ayettey Zubaidah has ever acted as his lawyer, or given him any form of legal advice.

FACT – Any human being has the right to file a grievance to the Ohio Supreme Court Disciplinary Counsel accepts complaints filed against attorneys and judges.

FACT – The definition of the word **PETITION** is: a request made for something desired, especially a respectful or humble request, as to a superior or to one of those in authority; a supplication or prayer; a petition for aid; a petition to GOD for coverage and strength.

FACT – The definition of the word **PUBLIC**: open to all persons; in the service of a community or nation, especially as a government officer; a public official.

FACT – I, King Ayettey Zubaidah, Stanl'e Riley and Julian Hill all board members of STAND SOCIETY met with D. Chris Cook on August 11, 2010 and came to a verbal agreement that the **STAND SOCIETY was not practicing law and I have the conversation on tape.**

COUNT THREE
(ISAIAH HARRIS)

FACT – Isaiah Harris has never stated that King Ayettey Zubaidah has ever acted his lawyer, or given him any form of legal advice.

Page#130, Q. #23, All right. Would you agree that the gist or the heart of that letter appears to be a character reference on behalf of Isaiah Harris?

Page#131, A. #1, This letter?

Q. #2, Yes.

A. #3, Absolutely.

Q. #10 It's not practicing law in any shape or form, is he?

A. #17, He doesn't cite any law or cases.

Q. #20, All right . But you agree, it's not practicing law, right?

A. #22, This is just a letter to the Judge.

On page# 132, Q. #6, And often times, we request civic leaders, people on counsel, union leaders, prominent people in the county to write character references for our clients, when they're in trouble, to the Judge, correct?

A. #10, Fair.

Q. #12, That's not practicing law, is it?

A. #13, No, I don't believe so.

Q. #14, And that's no different than Exhibit 21, is it?

A. #16, I think that's fair.

On page # 134 from #7 - #21.: Q. #7, Lay people are allowed to quote DR rules and ethical considerations if they can find them wherever they can find them, right?

A. #10, I would agree with that.

Q. # 17, And if he's writing a letter to a lawyer, he can quote those, right?

A.16, I believe so.

Q. #20, And that's not practicing law, is it?

A. #21, I would agree with that.

Q. #9, All right. It was never to practice law was it?

A. #11 No.

FACT- J. Anthony Rich agreed FIVE (5) times with attorney Michael Duff

that King Ayettey Zubaidah was NOT practicing law.

Judge Rothgery on pages 246 #9 referring to exhibit 21, page 249 #Q.17, This letter starts out and tells us this is a character reference, doesn't it? A.25, I would say that 90 percent of it seems to-page 250, #1-2, be referring to character, and lesser parts seem to be referring to guilt or innocence. - 257 #A. by Judge Rothery 13 -14 at it as simply a letter – a character reference, if you will.

FACT – Judge Rothgery final testimony is exhibit 21 is a character letter.

I.CONCLUSION/RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1.Respondent recommends that the Supreme Court of Ohio issue and order finding that King Ayetty Zubaidah/Stand Inc.is NOT guilty of the unauthorized practice of law.
- 2.Respondent recommends that the Supreme Court of Ohio waive and dismiss all charges and any penalties against King Ayetty Zubaidah/Stand Inc in the amount of \$5000 for each of the four counts, for a total penalty of \$20,000 both jointly and severally with expenses and cost.
- 3.Respondent recommends that the Supreme Court of Ohio issue and Order to the Lorain County Bar Association and The Board of Commissioners on the Unauthorized Practice of Law Supreme Court of Ohio to issue a cease and desist order and not retaliate against King Ayetty Zubaidah/Stand Society and its members in the future.
- 4.Respondent recommends that all expenses incurred by the Respondent be paid in the total of \$1,684.00
