

Now comes Timothy A. Swanson, who first being duly sworn according to law, upon personal knowledge and information, states as follows:

1. The affiant was elected Stark County Sheriff in the general elections of 2000, 2004, and 2008. Prior to the election in 2000, affiant was appointed Sheriff in 1999.
2. The affiant did not run for re-election for Stark County Sheriff in 2012.
3. At the General Election held in Stark County, Ohio, on November 6, 2012, Michael A. McDonald ("McDonald") was elected to serve as Stark County, Ohio Sheriff for the term commencing January 7, 2013. McDonald was the Democrat candidate for the Office of Sheriff.
4. Before he assumed office, McDonald reported to the Stark County Commissioners that he would not be able to assume the duties of Sheriff, for health reasons.

5. The Stark County Board of Commissioners appointed the affiant as interim Sheriff, on January 4, 2013 until a qualified candidate could be appointed. Upon such appointment, I took the oath of office and a bond was posted.

6. The Democratic Central Committee appointed an unqualified candidate to hold the office of Sheriff on February 5, 2013.

7. The putative candidate, and person now claiming the office of Sheriff, George Maier, does not meet the requirements of R.C. 311.01(B) (8) and/or (B)(9) as more fully developed and set forth in the complaint for writ of quo warranto.

8. Other qualified candidates were available for appointment on February 5, 2013 that were not appointed by the Democratic Central Committee, and only those qualified candidates as of that date should be considered for appointment to the Office of Sheriff.

9. At the Central Committee meeting on February 5, 2013, the Stark County Prosecutor expressed his opinion that George Maier did not meet the requisite qualifications defined by law, pursuant to R. C. 311.01 *et. seq.* Despite this opinion from the Stark County Prosecutor, the Central Committee permitted George Maier to be placed on the ballot of alleged qualified candidates.

10. George Maier was sworn as a peace officer on February 8, 2013, and obtained a bond on February 11, 2013. The current website for Stark County Sheriff list George Maier as Sheriff, and he has assumed duties of the office despite failing to meet the qualifications required by law.


Now Comes John D. Ferrero, first being duly sworn according to law and states as follows:

- 1) That he is the duly elected Prosecuting Attorney for Stark County, Ohio.
- 2) That pursuant to R.C. 309.09 he is required to represent Sheriff Timothy Swanson.
- 3) That Sheriff Swanson has made a formal request that Prosecuting Attorney John D. Ferrero file a legal action on Swanson's behalf as the duly appointed and qualified interim Sheriff recognized to perform the duties of Sheriff until such time as an individual is appointed and qualified.
- 4) That John D. Ferrero is a member of the Stark County Democratic Central Committee that voted to appoint George Maier to the office of Sheriff.
- 5) That John D. Ferrero has several assistant prosecuting attorneys on staff, who are also members of the Stark County Democratic Central Committee.
- 6) That as voting members of the Democratic Central Committee he and his staff members are potential witness in any underlying action.
- 7) That the Rule 3.7 of the Ohio Rules of Professional Conduct prohibit a lawyer from acting as an advocate in any case in which he is likely to be a material witness.
- 8) That he has reviewed the alleged qualifications of George Maier, who was selected by the Central Committee on February 5, 2013 as the appointee for Stark County Sheriff, and it is his opinion that Mr. Maier does not meet the qualifications of R.C. 311.01(B)(8) and/or (B)(9), and this opinion was expressed at the Committee meeting on February 5, 2013.



- 9) That he can not perform his statutory duty to advise and represent Acting Sheriff Tim Swanson without violating his duty to advise and represent presumptive Sheriff George Maier, who was appointed by the Stark County Democratic Executive Committee. The prosecutor's duty is to represent the rightful officeholder. Until such time as the Court determines who in fact is entitled to the rights and privileges of the office the prosecuting attorney can not ethically advise either claimant to the office with regard to their claims against one another.





and to determine what Stark will consider for prior learning and transfer credits for the student's academic career at Stark. Additionally, prior learning assessments are done to give credit toward work experience. Completing a prior learning assessment does not mean the student has earned credits at Stark, but rather what will be considered valid transfer or work experience credits for a student's degree at Stark.

5. Prior learning assessments are governed by Stark policy nos. 3357-15-13-25, 3357:15-13-41; and 3357:15-13-03. Exhibit 1 to this Affidavit is a true and accurate copy of Stark's policies. Typically, the process at Stark for a prior learning assessment review is first for the student to apply online for admission into Stark. Then the student selects a major and semester for admission, and provides pertinent information on past education and experience.

6. After the student's application is complete and accepted, the student can submit additional documents for the prior learning assessment review such as portfolio, work experience, proof of professional certifications and transcripts from other colleges and universities.

7. Stark uses a record management system to record every student's submission of transcripts and other prior learning credits. Initially I will evaluate the student's prior credits and work experience to determine what, if any, credit could be given to the student based on the degree program in which they are enrolled. Then I give the registrar or records office the information on transfer and prior learning credits to input into the records management system which creates a transcript. The purpose of the transcript is to set forth the credits that will be transferred for a student at Stark.

8. Pursuant to Stark policy no. 3357:15-13-41, a maximum of 30 credit hours - including transfer credits, proficiency examinations, or prior learning experience - may be used by a student toward completion of an associate degree at Stark. Approval by the Provost is needed to apply more than 30 credit hours. Exhibit 2 to this Affidavit is a true and accurate copy of Stark's policy. Pursuant to Stark policy no. 3357:15-13-03, to earn a degree at Stark at least 18 semester hours of technical or major courses in a degree program must be complete at Stark. Exhibit 3 to this Affidavit is a true and accurate copy of Stark's policy.


9. Since April 8, 2012 I have personally reviewed student's information for prior learning assessments approximately 5 times a week.

10. Along with Wallace Hoffer, Dean of Students at Stark, I assessed George Maier's prior learning assessment in accordance with Stark's policy.

11. On January 15, 2013, Maier applied to Stark as a Technical Studies Major for Summer Semester 2013. Exhibit 4 to this Affidavit is a true and accurate copy of Maier's application. Additionally, Maier provided transcripts and other documentations to complete his prior learning assessment. Exhibit 5 to this Affidavit is a true and accurate copy of the documentation provided by Maier.



**ARTICULATION AND TRANSFER**

Effective:

Policy No. 3357:15-13-25

Page 1 of 6

**POLICY:**

Stark State College abides by the Ohio Board of Regents' Ohio Articulation and Transfer Policy. [<http://regents.ohio.gov/transfer/policy/index.php>].

1. Transferability of Credits. The Ohio Board of Regents in 1990, following a directive of the 119<sup>th</sup> Ohio General Assembly, developed the Ohio Articulation and Transfer Policy to facilitate students' ability to transfer credits from one Ohio public college or university to another in order to avoid duplication of course requirements. A subsequent policy review and recommendations produced by the Articulation and Transfer Advisory Council in a 2004, together with mandates from the 125<sup>th</sup> Ohio General Assembly in the form of Amended Substitute House Bill 95, have prompted improvements of the original policy. While all state-assisted colleges and universities are required to follow the Ohio Articulation and Transfer Policy, independent colleges and universities in Ohio may or may not participate in the transfer policy. Therefore, students interested in transferring to independent institutions are encouraged to check with the college or university of their choice regarding transfer agreements. In support of improved articulation and transfer processes, the Ohio Board of Regents will establish a transfer clearinghouse to receive, annotate and convey transcripts among state-assisted colleges and universities. This system is designed to provide standardized information and help colleges and universities reduce undesirable variability in the transfer credit evaluation process.
2. Transfer of credit from other institutions will be determined upon receipt of an official transcript. Depending on the major, students can earn the first two years of a bachelor's degree and transfer out to area four-year colleges and universities. Students also can transfer up to 30 credit hours from another college or university and earn an associate degree or certificate. Refer to policies 3357:15-13-03, 15-13-17, and 15-13-18.

**PROCEDURE:**

1. Conditions for Transfer Admission
  - a. Ohio residents with associate degrees from state-assisted institutions and a completed, approved Transfer Module shall be admitted to a state institution of higher education in Ohio, provided their cumulative grade point average is at least 2.0 for all previous college-level courses. Further, these students shall have

admission priority over out-of-state associate degree graduates and transfer students.

- b. When students have earned associate degrees but have not completed a Transfer Module, they will be eligible for preferential consideration for admission as transfer students if they have grade point averages of at least a 2.0 for all previous college-level courses.
  - c. In order to encourage completion of the baccalaureate degree, students who are not enrolled in an A.A., A.S., or Applied Associate degree programs but have earned 60 semester or 90 quarter hours or more of credit toward a baccalaureate degree with a grade point average of at least a 2.0 for all previous college-level courses will be eligible for preferential consideration for admission as transfer students.
  - d. Students who have not earned an A.A., A.S., or Applied Associate degree programs or who have not earned 60 semester hours or 90 quarter hours of credit with a grade point average of at least a 2.0 for all previous college-level courses are eligible for admission as transfer students on a competitive basis.
  - e. Incoming transfer students admitted to a college or university shall compete for admission to selective programs, majors, and units on an equal basis with students native to the receiving institution. Admission to a given institution, however, does not guarantee that a transfer student will be automatically admitted to all majors, minors, or fields of concentration at the institution. Once admitted, transfer students shall be subject to the same regulations governing applicability of catalog requirements as native students. Furthermore, transfer students shall be accorded the same class standing and other privileges as native students on the basis of the number of credits earned. All residency requirements must be completed at the receiving institution.
2. Acceptance of Transfer Credit. To recognize courses appropriately and provide equity in the treatment of incoming transfer students and students native to the receiving institution, transfer credit will be accepted for all successfully completed college-level courses completed in and after Fall 2005 from Ohio state-assisted institutions of higher education which are accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools or other regional accrediting commissions which have been recognized by the Council on Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA). Students who successfully completed A.A., A.S., or Applied Associate degrees prior to Fall 2005 with a 2.0 or better overall grade point average would also receive credit for all college level courses they have passed. (See Ohio Articulation and Transfer Policy, Definition of Passing Grade and Appendix D.) While this reflects the baseline policy requirement, individual institutions may set equitable institutional policies that are more accepting. Pass/fail courses, credit by examination courses, experiential learning courses,

and other nontraditional credit courses that meet these conditions will also be accepted and posted to the student record.

3. Responsibilities of Students. In order to transfer with maximum applicability of transfer credit, prospective transfer students should plan a course of study that will meet the requirements of a degree program at the receiving institution. The student is responsible for seeking out the information and advising necessary to develop such a plan. Delays in the developing and following an appropriate plan or changes in plans may reduce the eventual applicability of transfer credit to the degree program ultimately selected.

Transfer students should:

- a. Seek out the program/degree and transfer information and an advisor to assist them in preparing a course of study to meet the academic requirements for the intended program/degree; consult the u.select [<https://www.transfer.org/uselect/>], Transfer Assurance Guides, and other information relevant to their educational goals; select courses which satisfy requirements at the receiving institution in order to maximize applicability of transfer credit;
  - b. Be aware that remedial and developmental courses will generally not be transferable or applicable to any degree program.
  - c. Be aware that changes in the course of study most likely will reduce the number of credits which are applicable to the program ultimately selected at both the sending and receiving institutions;
  - d. Understand the application fees, transfer admission, course transfer, financial aid, scholarship, and housing policies and procedures of the colleges and universities to which they plan to apply;
  - e. Be aware of the deadlines, restrictions, and other criteria such as the policies regarding deposits required prior to enrollment and the dates when refunds of those deposits are available;
  - f. Complete all material required for application and submit the application on or before deadlines;
  - g. Notify each college or university that accepts them for admission whether they are accepting or rejecting its offer as soon as they have heard from all the institutions to which they applied or by the deadline date set by the respective institution; and
  - h. Confirm their intention to enroll and submit a deposit to only one college or university by its required notification date.
4. Appeal Process. Following the evaluation of a student transcript from another institution, the receiving institution shall provide the student with a statement of transfer credit applicability. At the same time, the institution must inform the student of the institution's appeals process, should he or she wish to contest the evaluation. A student disagreeing with the application of transfer credit by the receiving institution must file his or her appeal in writing within ninety (90) days of receipt of the statement of transfer credit

applicability with the Dean of Admissions. The institution shall respond to the appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of the appeal, at each appeal level.

5. Transfer Module. The Ohio Board of Regents' Transfer and Articulation Policy established the Transfer Module, which is a subset or entire set of a college or university's general education curriculum in A.A., A.S and baccalaureate degree programs. Students in applied associate degree programs may complete some individual transfer module courses within their degree program or continue beyond the degree program to complete the entire transfer module. The Transfer Module contains 54-60 quarter hours or 36-40 semester hours of course credit in English composition (minimum 5-6 quarter hours or 3 semester hours); mathematics, statistics and formal/symbolic logic (minimum of 3 quarter hours or 3 semester hours); arts/humanities (minimum 9 quarter hours or 6 semester hours); social and behavioral sciences (minimum of 9 quarter hours or 5 semester hours); and natural sciences (minimum 9 quarter hours or 6 semester hours). Oral communication and interdisciplinary areas may be included as additional options. Additional elective hours from among these areas make up the total hours for a completed Transfer Module. Courses for the Transfer Module should be 100- and 200-level general education courses commonly completed in the first two years of a student's course of study. Each state-assisted university, technical and community college is required to establish and maintain an approved Transfer Module. Individual courses that are part of an approved Transfer Module are guaranteed to transfer among public institutions of higher education on a course-by-course basis. Students will receive credit for successfully completed courses from the Transfer Module without completing the entire module. For updated Transfer Module information, please go to the Stark State College Web site, [[www.starkstate.edu/transfermodule](http://www.starkstate.edu/transfermodule)].
6. Transfer Assurance Guides (TAGs). Transfer Assurance Guides (TAGs) comprise Transfer Module courses and additional courses required for an academic major. A TAG is an advising tool to assist Ohio university and community and technical college students planning specific majors to make course selections that will ensure comparable, compatible, and equivalent learning experiences across the state's higher-education system. TAGs empower students to make informed course selection decisions and plans for their future transfer. Advisors at the institution to which a student wishes to transfer should also be consulted during the transfer process. Students may elect to complete the full TAG or any subset of courses from the TAG. Because of specific major requirements, early identification of a student's intended major is encouraged. For updated TAG information, please go to the Ohio Board of Regents Web site, [<http://regents.ohio.gov/transfer/tagcourses/index.php>].
7. Career Technical Credit Transfer (CT2). Legislation directs the Ohio Board of Regents to work collaboratively with the Ohio Department of Education, public adult and secondary career technical education, and state-supported institutions of higher education to establish criteria, policies, and procedures to transfer agreed upon technical courses

from one system to another. For additional course transfer information, please contact the Chair of your selected program.

8. Credit by Proficiency Examination. A student who can demonstrate ability and knowledge in a particular subject area may establish credit in certain courses without enrolling in them. This is done by taking a special examination or performing a special assignment, or both, through the subject department chair.
  - a. A proficiency examination form must be obtained from and filed with a subject department chair. After permission has been granted to take the proficiency examination, the proficiency examination fee, as specified in the Fees rule 3357:15-18-09 of the Administrative Code must be paid at the Business Office. This form and the fee-paid receipt must be presented to the examiner at the time of the exam.
  - b. If a student has enrolled in a course, he is not eligible to take a proficiency examination for the course after being enrolled for twenty calendar days or more for a regular term and seven term days or more for an eight-week summer session. The refund policy is specified in the Fees rule 3357:15-18-09 of the Administrative Code.
  - c. Credit by proficiency examination requires the prior approval of the assessment tool by the department chair.
  - d. Credit for the course, after a satisfactory proficiency examination, will become a part of the student's permanent record, although no quality points are applied for the "CR" grade for the proficiency examination.
  - e. The privilege of attempting to demonstrate proficiency by examination is limited to a single attempt per course.
  - f. A student who has received credit by proficiency examination will not be required to take additional credit hours in lieu of the credit hours earned through such an examination.
9. Credit for Professional Exams, Licensure, or Certifications. Students currently taking a credit course in their declared major at Stark State College may be eligible for a maximum of 30 hours of credit in that major if they hold appropriate and current certification(s) or licensure(s) or have passed a current professional exam(s). The department chair will determine the acceptability of these credentials with the approval of the division dean.
  - a. The student will complete the "Credit for Professional Exams, Licensure or Certifications Application" and will attach a copy of the appropriate documentation.
  - b. The department chair and division dean will review the documentation for approval.
  - c. Upon approval, the department chair will forward the signed request with appropriate documentation to the Academic Records/Registrar's office for

processing. This documentation will become part of the student's academic file and the official transcript
