Re: Qualifications for Sheriff

Dear Mr. Maier:

You have asked me whether or not your background and experience qualifies you to run for Sheriff of Stark County. I have reviewed all applicable statutes, rules, regulations and comments to applicable law and conclude that your qualifications qualify you to run for sheriff. My analysis in part, follows:

Ohio Revised Code Chapter 311 governs sheriffs in Ohio. Section 311.01 sets forth with great particularity, the qualifications for sheriff. There are nine specific qualifications set forth in §311.01(B). The first seven which are set forth below are not at issue. They are:

1. The person is a citizen of the United States.
2. The person has been a resident of the county for at least one year immediately prior to the qualification date. The qualification date is the last day on which a candidate for sheriff can file to seek the office.
3. The person has the qualifications of an elector or voter.
4. The person has a high school diploma or equivalency.
5. The person has not been convicted or pled guilty to a felony or an offense involving moral turpitude and has not been convicted of or pled guilty to an offense that is a misdemeanor of the first degree.
6. The person has been fingerprinted and has been the subject of a review of applicable fingerprint files to disclose any criminal record.

7. The person has prepared a complete history of his residences for a period of six years immediately preceding the qualification date, as well as a listing of employment and forwarded the same to the Administrative Judge of the Court of Common Pleas. Please note that the role of the Administrative Judge in receiving such information is not to engage in an analysis but to forward them with the findings of the fingerprint results set forth in number 6 above to the Board of Elections, Board of County Commissioners or Political Party Central Committee.

It is my understanding that you qualify under sections 1 through 7 above. At issue are sections 8 and 9.

Section 8 states as follows:

- (8) The person meets at least one of the following conditions:
 - (a) Has obtained or held, within the four-year period ending immediately prior to the qualification date,
 - a valid basic peace officer certificate of training issued by the Ohio peace officer training commission or has been issued a certificate of training pursuant to section 5503.05 of the Revised Code,
 - and,**
 - within the four-year period ending immediately prior to the qualification date, has been employed as an appointee pursuant to section 5503.01 of the Revised Code or as a full-time peace officer as defined in section 109.71 of the Revised Code performing duties related to the enforcement of statutes, ordinances, or codes;
 - OR-
 - (b) Has obtained or held, within the three-year period ending immediately prior to the qualification date,
 - a valid basic peace officer certificate of training issued by the Ohio peace officer training commission
 - and**
 - has been employed for at least the last three years prior to the qualification date as a full-time law enforcement officer, as defined in division (A)(11) of section 2901.01 of the Revised Code, performing duties related to the enforcement of statutes, ordinances, or codes.

Thus, a candidate must satisfy either 8(a) or 8(b) but not both. A candidate seeking to qualify under 8(a) must have a training certificate that was valid for at least one day during the

four years immediately prior to the applicable qualification date and have been employed fulltime as a member of the Ohio Highway Patrol or as a peace officer performing duties that involved enforcing the law, for at least one day during the four years immediately before the qualification date.

You were a peace officer appointed by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission. You have commissions issued by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission dated July 24, 2008 and November 18, 2009. A Notice of Termination as a Peace Officer is dated January 7, 2011. Therefore, you meet the first provision of section 8(a). The second provision requires that during the time at issue, you were a fulltime Peace Officer performing duties related to the enforcement of statutes, ordinances, or codes. You meet the definition of a fulltime Peace Officer as defined in §109.71 of the Ohio Revised Code, in your role both as a Deputy Sheriff in Pickaway as well as in the roles of Director and Assistant Director of the Department of Public Safety. In these roles, you performed duties related to the enforcement of statutes, ordinances or codes. In fact, the job description as Assistant Director of the Department of Public Safety, one position you held within the last four years, contains job responsibilities which specifically state that you supervise and direct the coordination of all criminal investigations with various other agencies and government, ensure compliance with the Department of Public Safety policies and procedures governing the accreditation of officers and assist the Director in supervising all operations of the department. Compliance with Section 8 is met.

Section 9 requires you to meet at least one of the following conditions:

(9) The person meets at least one of the following conditions:

(a) Has at least two years of supervisory experience as a peace officer at the rank of corporal or above, or has been appointed pursuant to section 5503.01 of the Revised Code and served at the rank of sergeant or above, in the five-year period ending immediately prior to the qualification date;

(b) Has completed satisfactorily at least two years of post-secondary education or the equivalent in semester or quarter hours in a college or university authorized to confer degrees by the Ohio board of regents or the comparable agency of another state in which the college or university is located or in a school that holds a certificate of registration issued by the state board of career colleges and schools under Chapter 3332. of the Revised Code.

You must satisfy either 9(a) or 9(b) but not both. You must either have the supervisory experience required or the post-high school educational experience. You have both. The supervisory experience indicates one must serve at the rank of sergeant or above. As Assistant Director and Director of the Department of Public Safety, you performed above this rank, however, even if one was to conclude to the contrary, that a Director or Assistant Director of the Department of Public Safety is not in the rank of sergeant or above (which I contend it is), you

have satisfactory completed at least two years of post-secondary education, as necessary. I am aware that Stark State College has reviewed your college transcripts for prior learning credit assessment/work experience credit and based on its review, has determined an equivalency of 67 college-level credit hours. Stark State College has affirmed that these 67 credit hours are beyond the training hours required from the Ohio Police Officer's Training Academy. Thus, you meet the requirement of section 9(b) and I contend you also meet the requirement of section 9(a). However, you only need to meet one of these two sections not both. Therefore, you meet the requirements to be a candidate for sheriff of Stark County.

139.01 OFFICES MERGED.

The office of Director of Public Safety is merged with that of the office of Director of Public Service, under one Director to be known as Director of Public Service and Safety, who shall be appointed by the Mayor. (1957 Code Sec. 129.01.)

DIRECTOR of SAFETY and SERVICE

Description - Under the general direction of the Mayor, the Director of Safety and Service is responsible for the overall safe, efficient and economical operation of the Departments of Police, Fire, and Streets, Parks and Cemeteries. In addition, the Director of Safety and Service is the chief administrative assistant to the Mayor.

Examples of Job Duties

1. Plans short and long range goals and objectives necessary to meet future needs and requirements and to maintain and improve services.
2. Determines priorities and methods of operation; monitors activities to insure goals and objectives are met and they comply with needs and requirements.
3. Approves departmental budget and appropriations; recommends approval to Mayor and City Council.
4. Administers and enforces subdivision regulations, zoning ordinances, contracts and state and federal grants to insure compliance with laws and/or rules and regulations and contractual obligations are met.
5. Establishes traffic and parking regulations needed to meet needs of the City and insure safe and efficient flow of traffic.
6. Supervises preparation of bids, specifications, legal notices, contracts; prepares correspondence, etc. to provide information, comply with legal requirements and purchase materials and services; evaluates bids, selects vendors.
7. Issues licenses and zoning certificates to applicants to insure compliance with laws and/or rules and regulations.
8. Supervises employees, assigns projects, evaluates performance, provides guidance, direction and counsels in an effort to improve performance and maintain positive morale.
9. Represents departments in City Council meetings, Planning Commission and in meetings with other public and/or private groups to provide information, resolve complaints and obtain approval of resolutions, ordinances and new or revised policies, practices and procedures.
10. Prepares budgets and appropriations to provide information needed to obtain approval for levels of spending.
11. Authorizes all purchases, major discipline, new hires, pay increases, major projects, major policy changes, etc. to maintain consistency and efficiency of operations and comply with legal requirements.
12. Serves on Board of Control for approval of contracts.
13. Coordinates disaster planning with affected organizations to insure smooth and efficient operation in emergency situations.
14. Conducts staff meetings to communicate and receive ideas and information in order for employees to remain knowledgeable and current of proper procedures and methods of operation.

15. Attends seminars, workshops, training sessions, staff meetings, etc. to remain knowledgeable and current of agency policy and obtain new ideas in area of specialization.

16. Any other similar and/or related duties deemed necessary by the Mayor.


