

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

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

I, George T. Maier, being first duly cautioned and sworn states as follows:

1. I am over the age of 18 and a resident of Stark County, Ohio.
2. On February 6, 2013, following a vote the previous day by the Central Committee of the Democratic Party, Stark County, Ohio. I received a commission from Governor John Kasich to the position of Sheriff of Stark County, Ohio. A copy of Governor Kasich's Commission and my Oath of Office are attached as Exhibits 1 and 2 hereto.
3. I began my career in law enforcement in 1980 as a police officer for the Lawrence Township Police Department in Stark County, Ohio. In 1981 I joined the Village of Hartville Police Department in Stark County, Ohio. In both positions I was a police officer.
4. In 1983, I joined the Ohio State Highway Patrol as a Trooper. I served in this capacity until 1993. In 1991, I was honored by the Ohio State Highway Patrol as "State Trooper of the Year."
5. In 1993, I became an Assistant Post Commander with the Ohio State Highway Patrol and served in this role and as Sergeant through 1998.
6. In 1998, I became Post Commander-Lieutenant of the Ohio State Highway Patrol at its Steubenville, Ohio location where I served as commander of 17 uniformed officers and 9 non-sworn professional staff. I served in this role until 2002.
7. In 2002, I became the Assistant District Commander of the Ohio State Highway Patrol in Massillon, Ohio with primary responsibility for staff and support functions of district operations and operational functions with other command posts. I managed a staff of 145 sworn

officers and 103 non-sworn professional staff. I directed law enforcement efforts within a 7-county area.

8. In 2004, I became the District Commander of the Ohio State Highway Patrol based in Jackson, Ohio where I served as commander of 132 uniformed officers and 83 non-sworn professional staff members. I managed the administrative and operational functions of a 10 county district with 6 patrol posts spread throughout the district. I performed this role until I retired from the Ohio State Highway Patrol in May, 2007.

9. In May, 2007, I was appointed to be Assistant Public Safety Director for the State of Ohio. I was appointed by the Governor of the State of Ohio to this position. Attached as **Exhibit 3** is my position description job as Assistant Director of the Ohio Department of Public Safety. Among my duties were to supervise and direct the coordination of all criminal investigations with the Governor's Chief Legal Counsel and the State Highway Patrol. In addition, I assisted the Director of the Ohio Department of Public Safety in defining goals, objectives and the formulation of policies, procedures and rules necessary for the management and operation of the department. I served in this position until I was appointed interim Director of the Department of Public Safety on January 1, 2011.

10. On January 1, 2011, I was appointed Director of Public Safety. The position description for my job is attached as **Exhibit 4**. As a direct report to the Governor of the State of Ohio, I was responsible for all operations of the Department of Public Safety including oversight of the Ohio State Highway Patrol, Ohio Investigative Unit, and other divisions. It was my responsibility to formulate and set policy including those related to the enforcement of statutes, ordinances, and codes. Among those I was charged with the responsibility to directly supervise was the Colonel of the Ohio State Highway Patrol (see bottom left corner of position description

Exhibit 4 indicating the titles of positions directly supervised). I served as Director of Public Safety until such time as new Governor Kasich installed his leadership team.

11. On or about July 31, 2008, I received an appointment as a Peace Officer from the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (“OPOTA”) as an agent for the Ohio Investigative Unit of the Ohio Department of Public Safety. This was a full-time appointment. I was issued a badge, weapon and performed duties related to criminal investigations, enforcements and arrests. A copy of my Appointment is attached as **Exhibit 5**.

12. My Ohio Peace Officer Appointment was updated on November 18, 2009, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit 6**.

13. Effective January 6, 2011, my Peace Officer Certificate was terminated as a result of my discharge from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, following the change in administrations, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit 7**.

14. Accordingly, although not all Directors and Assistant Directors of the Ohio Department of Public Safety are OPOTA approved Peace Officers, I was while serving in both roles from May 21, 2007 through early January, 2011.

15. As part of the process to seek appointment as Stark County Sheriff from the Stark County Democratic Party Central Committee, I submitted my qualifications to the Administrative Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Stark County, the Honorable Frank Forchione. Attached hereto as **Exhibit 8** is a letter issued by Administrative Judge Forchione to Brenda Vogley of Stark State College.

16. I am qualified to be the Sheriff of Stark County because:

- a. I am a citizen of the United States.

- b. I have been a resident of Stark County for not less than one year prior to the qualification date for the appointment of Stark County Sheriff.
- c. I have the qualifications of an elector as specified in Section 3503.01 of the Revised Code and have complied with all applicable election laws.
- d. I have been awarded a high school diploma or a certificate of high school equivalence issued for achievement of specified minimum scores from the general education development test of the American council on education.
- e. I have not been convicted of or pled guilty to a felony or any offense involving moral turpitude under the laws of this or any other state or the United States and have not been convicted of nor pled guilty to an offense that is a misdemeanor of the first degree under the laws of this state, or an offense under the laws of any other state or the United States that carries a penalty that is substantially equivalent to the penalty for a misdemeanor of the first degree under the laws of this state.
- f. I have been fingerprinted and have been the subject of a search of local, state, and national fingerprint files to disclose any criminal record. Such fingerprints were taken under the direction of the Administrative Judge of the Court of Common Pleas who, prior to the applicable qualification date, notified the Board of Elections, Board of County Commissioners, or County Central Committee of the proper political party as applicable, of the Judge's findings.
- g. I have prepared a complete history of my places of residence for a period of six years immediately preceding the qualification date and a complete

history of my places of employment for a period of six years immediately preceding the qualification date indicating the name and address of each employer and the period of time employed by that employer. The residence and employment histories were filed with the Administrative Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of the county who forwarded them with the findings set forth in Section f above to the appropriate Board of Elections, Board of County Commissions or County Central Committee of the proper political party prior to the applicable qualification date.

h. I meet the following condition:

I have obtained or held within the four-year period ending immediately prior to the qualification date, a valid basic peace officer certificate of training issued by the Ohio peace officer training commission or have been issued a certificate of training pursuant to Section 5503.05 of the Revised Code, and, within the four-year period ending immediately prior to the qualification date, have been employed as an appointee pursuant to Section 5503.01 of the Revised Code or as a full-time peace officer as defined in Section 109.71 of the Revised Code performing duties related to the enforcement of statutes, ordinance or codes.


i. I meet one or both of the following conditions:

a) I have at least two years of supervisory experience as a peace officer at the rank of corporal or above, or have been appointed pursuant to Section 5503.01 of the Revised Code and served at the


rank of sergeant or above, in the five-year period ending immediately prior to the qualification date; or


- b) I have completed satisfactorily at least two-years of post-secondary education or the equivalent in semester or quarter hours in a college or university authorized to confer degrees by the Ohio board of regents or the comparable agency of another state in which the college or university is located or in a school that holds a certificate of registration issued by the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools under Chapter 3332 of the Revised Code.

Recently I received a letter from you on behalf of George T. Maier, a possible candidate for Stark County Sheriff, regarding your review of the materials and transcripts that he provided in which you determined an equivalency of 67 college level credit hours which were beyond the training hours required from the basic Police Officers Training Academy (POTA).

At this point, Mr. Maier is considering a candidacy for the Stark County Sheriff. As the Administrative Judge for Stark County, it is my role to determine if Mr. Maier has met all qualifications for candidates for Sheriff. Under ORC 311.01 titled Election and Qualifications of Sheriff, it states in pertinent part as a requirement:

"...(b) has completed satisfactory at least two years of post secondary education or the equivalent in semester or quarter hours in a college or university authorized to confer degrees by the Ohio Board of Regents or the comparable agency of another state in which the college or university is located or any school that holds a certificate of registration issued by the State Board of Career Colleges and Schools under Chapter 3332 of the Revised Code." 
At this point, it is important that I exercise due diligence to make sure these requirements have been met. First, I would appreciate it if you could please advise me how many hours are needed to be considered full time for a semester. I'm also requesting a copy of the materials and transcripts that you have reviewed to determine the equivalency of 67 college level credit hours.

I've had the opportunity to review Ohio case law regarding issues involving satisfaction of the post secondary-education requirement of Revised Code 311.01(B)(9)(b). One of the main issues seems to be whether any of these credit hours should be considered for peace-officer training. If that is the case, they should not be counted towards the post secondary-education requirement. How did you make that determination? What was your basis?

I appreciate the letter that you forwarded on behalf of Mr. Maier, but due to the importance of the position, I believe it's critical that your initial letter be more defined and supplemented. It is axiomatic that the Stark County residents have a Sheriff who is properly qualified.

I, Randy Gonzalez, being first duly cautioned and sworn states as follows:

1. I am the Chairman of the Stark County Democratic Party and have been the Chairman throughout all the proceedings discussed herein.

2. On November 6, 2012, Michael A. McDonald was elected to the Office of Sheriff of Stark County.

3. On January 3, 2013, Mr. McDonald issued notice that due to a change in his medical condition, he was unable to assume the Office of Sheriff of Stark County. Mr. McDonald passed away in mid-February, 2013. A copy of Mr. McDonald's letter of January 3, 2013 is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**.

4. As a result of the vacancy created by Mr. McDonald being unable to assume the Office of Sheriff of Stark County, I called a meeting of the Central Committee of the Stark County Democratic Party for the purposes of electing an individual to fill the vacancy in the Office of Sheriff as required by law.

5. The meeting of the Stark County Democratic Party Central Committee occurred on February 5, 2013 at the Mayfield Senior Center in Canton, Ohio. As Chairman, I ran the meeting.

6. Attached as **Exhibit 2** are the minutes of the meeting of the Stark County Democratic Central Committee held on February 5, 2013.

7. In attendance at the meeting, was Bill DeMora, Secretary of the Ohio Democratic Party and an experience parliamentarian who oversaw all voting.

8. Consideration for appointment at the meeting of the Stark County Democratic Central Committee for the position of Sheriff were three individuals, George T. Maier, Lou Darrow, and Larry Dordea. Prior to the meeting, all three individuals had submitted applications to the administrative judge of the Stark County Common Pleas Court and their applications, issued through journal entries of the court, were forwarded to the Central Committee. The Journal Entry we received on George Maier is attached as **Exhibit 3**.

9. As stated in the minutes, during the meeting, a Central Committee member moved that the Central Committee nominate and consider all three candidates qualified for the Office of Sheriff. That motion was seconded. John Ferrero, a member of the Central Committee and also the Prosecutor of the Stark County said at the meeting, it was the Central Committee's duty to determine if all of the applicants were qualified.

10. The motion to consider all three candidates (George Maier, Lou Darrow and Larry Dordea) qualified for the Office of Sheriff passed following a roll call vote of all members of the Central Committee in attendance.

11. As stated in the minutes, voting by all Central Committee members in attendance occurred by written ballot signed by the committee members. The vote as announced by Mr. DeMora was 92 votes for George Maier, 84 votes for Lou Darrow and 1 vote for Larry Dordea. Two ballots were unsigned and therefore not counted.

12. Following the meeting, as chairperson of the Stark County Democratic Committee, I issued a Certification by Party Central Committee to fill a vacancy in a county office, indicating that George Maier had been appointed in accordance with the law. A copy of this Certification is attached as **Exhibit 4**.


13. In addition to that set forth above, I had two independent attorneys (not including Mr. Maier's personal counsel) review the qualifications of George Maier to serve as Sheriff. Both lawyers advised me that he met the legal qualifications to do so. As a result, I am convinced that Mr. Maier meets the legal qualifications to serve as Sheriff of Stark County.

14. As Chairman of the Stark County Democratic Party, I am aware that there are instances such as this one, where factions develop within the Party resulting in support for more than one candidate for office. This occurred in connection with the appointment of George Maier as Sheriff of Stark County. I contend that the current controversy is nothing more than intra-party squabbling among factions of Stark County Democratic Party, as these factions sought and continue to seek support for their candidates for sheriff.

15. It is my understanding that pursuant to the law, Mr. Maier shall serve as Sheriff until the November, 2014 election at which time he will run for the office to serve out the remainder of the term which shall expire in January, 2017.



Throughout these proceedings, the electoral process set forth in law has been followed, monitored by the Ohio Democratic Party and as stated above, the winner of the Central Committee vote has assumed the Office of Sheriff of Stark County. 





Call To Order


Stark County Democratic Party Chairman Randy Gonzalez called the meeting to order at 5:40 PM, and thanked all for coming. After the Pledge of Allegiance, Chairman Gonzalez announced that representatives of the Democratic clubs would be in the back of the room with information & membership cards. Also, the Democratic Woman's Club is having a Candidates Night on February 27th at 6:00 p.m. at Democratic Headquarters.

Remarks by Chairman Gonzalez

Chairman Randy Gonzalez welcomed all in attendance. He requested that only committee members be seated; all spectators should stand in the back of the room.

The Chairman stated the reason we are here this evening is that Michael McDonald suffered a major setback in his health; his stepping down is a great loss to the Sheriff's Office and, on a personal level, a tough weight to feel.

Member Cynthia Balas-Bratton repeatedly called for a point of order, asking to make a motion. She was asked to sit down by other Central Committee members & Chairman Gonzalez, who requested that she let us go forward with the meeting.



Voting Procedure Explained

The Chairman stated this will be a public vote tonight; that all elected Central Committee members represent the people who voted for them, & those people have every right to see how you vote. Chairman Gonzalez introduced Bill DeMora, Secretary of the Ohio Democratic Party & an experienced Parliamentarian, who would oversee the vote. The Chairman explained that every Committee member's name would be called; they would come forward to receive a ballot, and must sign the ballot in order for it to be counted. Five letters of interest were received at Democratic Headquarters; three have gone through the procedure at the Court of Common Pleas and were forwarded to the Central Committee: George Maier, Lou Darrow & Larry Dordea.

Motion to Table the Vote

Member Dave Kirven moved to table the vote until all candidates are qualified; seconded by Cynthia Balas-Bratton. Chairman Gonzalez stated he has hired Attorney Michael Thompson who researched & said we have three qualified candidates; & that Attorney Steve Okey was also asked for his opinion and confirmed we are on solid ground. After discussion, Chairman Gonzalez called for a roll call vote: the motion failed and the meeting continued.

Motion to Vote on the 3 Candidates

Member Ed Davila moved that we nominate and consider all three candidates qualified; motion seconded by Deametrious St. John.

Under discussion, Member John Ferrero, who filed an affidavit in the court case challenging George Maier's qualifications, said it was the Central Committee's duty to determine if all of the applicants were qualified. He said he would support whoever is elected tonight, but believes the party could put itself at risk of a second lawsuit. Attorney Michael Thompson said any challenges to Maier's qualifications should be made after the

vote. Following more questions and discussion, Chairman Gonzalez restated the motion and a roll call vote was taken: the motion passed.

The Chairman announced that as the employees of the Board of Elections call members' names, they should come forward and receive their ballots and reminded them they must sign their ballots for their ballot to be counted.

Motion to Adjourn

Member Cynthia Balas-Bratton at this point moved to adjourn the meeting (no second required). Chairman Gonzalez called for all those in favor of adjourning to stand. Motion failed and the voting began.

Results of the Vote

Voting commenced via written ballot, signed by the committee members. Board of Elections employees, as overseen by Mr. DeMora, counted votes. The vote, announced by Mr. DeMora, was 84 votes for Mr. Darrow, 92 votes for Mr. Maier, 1 vote for Mr. Dordea, and 2 ballots unsigned & not counted. Mr. DeMora collected the ballots. Chairman Gonzalez thanked everyone for coming, congratulated George Maier and thanked Lou Darrow for contributing his experience to the Sheriff's Department. He also thanked Tim Swanson for being a friend to Stark County and the Sheriff's Office. He also announced the recent passing of a longtime Democrat & Central Committeeman, Andy Bartko. Member Derrick Loy moved to adjourn; motion seconded. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote. The meeting was adjourned at 6:56 p.m.



 - b. One (1) set of fingerprints shall be taken on a Federal Bureau of Investigation Applicant Card (FBI card), which shall be clearly marked "LAW ENFORCEMENT APPLICANT."
 - c. One (1) set of fingerprints shall be taken on a local law enforcement fingerprint card as recognized and utilized by the Stark County Sheriff's Office (SCSO card) and shall be clearly marked "LAW ENFORCEMENT APPLICANT."
3. Upon completion of the fingerprinting, the BCI card and the FBI card shall be delivered by the Officer taking said fingerprints to the Administrative Judge of the Common Pleas Court of Stark County for forwarding to the appropriate agencies, and the SCSO card shall be retained by the Stark County Sheriff's Office for the purposes of a record check of all local law enforcement agencies, which shall be conducted forthwith.

4. Upon completion of the local records check, the Sheriff or his designee shall deliver the results of the local record check to the Administrative Judge of the Common Pleas Court of Stark County, Ohio.

I, Glenn L. Taylor, Sr., being first duly cautioned and sworn states as follows:


1. I am over the age of 18 and a resident of Franklin County, Ohio.
2. From 2007 through 2011, I served as the Executive Director of the Ohio Investigative Unit (“OIU”) of the Ohio Department of Public Safety.
3. During my tenure as Executive Director of OIU, George T. Maier (“Maier”) served as my direct supervisor.
4. During my tenure as Executive Director of OIU, Maier also served as the supervisor over the Divisions of Administration, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, Emergency Management Agency, Emergency Medical Services, Homeland Security, State Highway Patrol, and the Office of Criminal Justice Services.
5. As the supervisor of OIU, Maier’s oversight included the management of a multi-million dollar budget, a staff of 120 employees, \$5,000,000 of State of Ohio assets, and \$25,000,000 of federal grants.
6. During Maier’s tenure, we implemented enforcement programs over gambling, alcohol, food stamp, and tobacco in the State of Ohio.
7. In addition to his administrative duties typically performed during traditional work hours of 8:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, Maier also worked nights and weekends with OIU on specific enforcement missions. These were often special, high profile enforcement missions, examples of which include but are not limited to the Ohio University Halloween party, Ohio State University Football games, Jamboree-in-the-Hills Country Concert and the like. Mr. Maier performed these duties in the capacity of lead

commanding officer of OIU, a law enforcement unit with full powers of arrest. Mr. Maier did so as a peace officer, as were the other enforcement agents at the scene, wearing a badge and having a weapon. In addition because these were high profile events involving large groups of people, Mr. Maier had the responsibility to review and approve the specific operational plans for our unit.

8. During my term as Executive Director of OIU, Maier was the lead commanding officer performing confidential, law enforcement security briefings, evidence oversight activities, and he was instrumental in directing the accreditation process through the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies ("CALEA") awarded to the OIU in November, 2009.


9. Throughout my tenure as Executive Director of OIU, I as well as other senior rank and file members of OIU recognized Maier as their supervisor in their chains of command.
