Dear Mr. Antony:

As you have been previously advised, the Supreme Court of Ohio has informed the clerk's office that it will not consider an application for reinstatement until the attorney has complied with the court's orders and Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio. After you filed your application for reinstatement on February 20, 2013, it was determined that you had not complied with all of the court's orders in this matter. Specifically, it was determined that you had failed to complete the requisite CLE hours as ordered by the court and set forth in Gov.Bar R. X(3)(G). In addition, you failed to file an affidavit of compliance and surrender your attorney registration card as ordered by the court.

You recently advised me that you have completed additional CLE hours. As we discussed, you must file a supplement to your application for reinstatement that contains the seminar information so that your credit for these seminars can be confirmed with the Office of Attorney Services.

In addition, while you submitted your attorney registration card in response to the court's show cause order, you failed to submit a sufficient affidavit of compliance. Because the time for you to respond to the show cause order has expired, you will be found in contempt for failing to file an affidavit of compliance. As we discussed, once the contempt order is put on, you will need to file a motion to purge contempt along with an affidavit of compliance before the court will consider your application for reinstatement.
