

Motion to Strike Dismissal

The Court has jurisdiction and must accept case involving The United States Constitution.

Mayor's Director of Planning Dianne Harris falsely issued a minor misdemeanor citation June 12, 2012 on property located at 8982 Mink Street S.W., ordering plaintiff to appear in mayor's court June 28, 2012 before defendant Hereditary magistrate Charles Kelsey, property not being in Pataskala's jurisdiction the case was transferred to Newark Municipal Court for trial by jury.

After plaintiff left the court magistrate Kelsey conferred with law director Rufus Hurst to have plaintiff arrested and brought back into court.

Leaving the parking lot, plaintiff was arrested by the court bailiff, handcuffed, said he did not know why the arrest just bring plaintiff back into court. Plaintiff was seated in the back of court until three police officers came, changed cuffs, plaintiff was taken to the front of the building searched, placed in the back of a cruiser with windows up,

motor not running and outside temperature of 96 degrees until magistrate gave order to bring plaintiff back into court.

Plaintiff seeks from Steve Butcher and the City of Pataskala through court judgment in plaintiff's favor and awarded \$250,000.00 two hundred fifty thousand dollars for wrongs, not know why he was arrested, violating plaintiff's U.S. Constitutional rights, mental disturbance of mind, injuries to health, damage of character.



ARTICLE VII

In suits at common law, where the value in controversy shall exceed twenty dollars, the right of trial by jury shall be preserved, and no fact tried by a jury, shall be otherwise reexamined in any court of the United States, than according to rules of the common law.

Defendant knowing she was violating the Constitution of United States, to protect her teaching (conflict of interest).

Plaintiff seeks judgment in his favor from the defendant and be awarded \$550,000.00 Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars from defendant for wrong violating plaintiff's U.S. Constitutional rights, mental disturbance of mind, injuries to health, and damage of character. Including cost of filing.
