


NOW COME Relators Paul Calvaruso, Elizabeth A. Daugherty, Michael G. Prebonick, Martha L. Sullivan, Sylvia D. Trundle, and Daniel D. Zampelli, Respondent Charles Brown and Intervenor City of Akron (collectively hereinafter the “Parties”), by and through their respective counsel, and jointly move for leave to clarify the record. The Parties independently submitted Evidence to the Court as filed on June 25, 2013. On Thursday June 27, 2013, Counsel for the Relators and counsel for the Intervenor and Respondent independently recognized the Parties made clerical errors in evidence submitted to this Court. As such, the Parties submit this joint motion for leave to clarify the record in order to rectify clerical errors. The parties *do not* ask to supplement the evidentiary record, but merely ask this Court for leave to clarify certain incidental clerical errors made in the Parties’ evidentiary filings.


On June 25, 2013, Respondent and Intervenor filed a document titled “Affidavit of Charles Brown.” Paragraph nine of Respondent Brown’s affidavit references Exhibit #2; however, Exhibit #2 is not attached to Respondent Brown’s affidavit. The Parties agree that the failure to attach Exhibit #2 is a clerical error. The Parties further agree that the attached document marked as “Brown Exhibit 2” is an accurate copy of what Respondent and Intervenor intended to file with the Court on June 25, 2013 as the attachment to Respondent Brown’s affidavit as identified in paragraph 9. Brown Exhibit 2 is also contained in Relators’ Exhibit O-2 as originally filed and clarified with the Court as discussed herein.

Due to a clerical error, Exhibit O-2, p.3 was incorrectly copied. The parties agree that this is a clerical error. The

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


Dear Ms. Cunningham:

This letter is to advise you of the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund's ("OP&F") decision on membership for City of Akron Assistant Chief of Police position. On November 21, 2012, OP&F received from your office a letter with the Assistant Chief of Police Job posting and Job description regarding eligibility for this position. Based upon the information that you have provided, the position does meet the criteria for OP&F membership.

Section 742.01 (A) (2) (a) of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) describes a member of OP&F as "any person who receives an original appointment as a full-time regular police officer in a police department from a duly established civil service eligible list or pursuant to section 124.411 [124.41.1] of the Revised Code, or who is described in section 742.511 [742.51.1] of the Revised Code, or who transfers from the public employees retirement system to the Ohio police and fire pension fund pursuant to section 742.513 [742.51.3] of the Revised Code, or who is appointed pursuant to section 737.15 or 737.16 of the Revised Code as a full-time regular police officer and is paid solely out of public funds of the employing municipal corporation." Section 742.301 (A) (2) (c) also defines a member of OP&F as "any person who commences employment on or after September 16, 1998, as a full-time police officer with a police department in a position in which the person is required to satisfactorily complete a peace officer training course in compliance with section 109.77 of the Revised Code."






