Dear Mr. Martin:

On December 15, 2011, you were suspended from the practice of law for a period of one year, the suspension was stayed and you were placed on monitored probation for a period of one year. A monitor was appointed by relator. Relator was ordered to file a report with the court at the end of your probationary period stating whether you complied with the conditions of probation and monitoring.

On July 1, 2013, you filed an Application for Termination of Probation. The Supreme Court of Ohio has informed the clerk's office that it will not consider an attorney's application for termination of probation until the court's orders and Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio have been fully complied with and the requirements for termination of probation have been met. Although the relator filed a notice of appointment of monitoring attorney on January 11, 2012, as of the date of this letter, the relator has not filed its report with the court. The court will not consider your termination of probation until such time as relator files this report with the clerk's office.
