

AFFIDAVIT

I, Richard A. Dove, having been duly sworn according to the laws of Ohio, hereby depose and say:

1. I am the Secretary to the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline of the Supreme Court of Ohio ("Board"). Pursuant to Rule V of the Supreme Court Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio, I am responsible for serving certified disciplinary complaints on the parties and maintaining the records of cases certified to the Board.
2. On June 10, 2013, a formal complaint was certified to the Board in the matter of *Mahoning County Bar Association v. Deneen Marie Marrelli*, Board Case No. 2013-035.
3. On June 10, 2013, a notice and copy of the certified complaint were sent via certified mail to the respondent at 46 Walter Street, Campbell, Ohio 44405. The address to which the certified mail was sent is the respondent's residence address and the only address reflected in the attorney registration records maintained by the Supreme Court of Ohio, Office of Attorney Services.
4. Also on June 10, 2013, a notice and copy of the certified complaint were sent via certified mail to the respondent at 5271 Stacy Street, Apt. A, West Palm Beach, Florida 33417. The address to which the certified mail was sent is the address on the certified complaint.
5. On June 24, 2013, the certified mail referenced in ¶3 was returned to the Board from the United States Postal Service and marked "return to sender, attempted-not known, unable to forward."
6. On June 28, 2013, the certified mail reference in ¶4 was returned to the Board from the United States Postal Service and marked "return to sender, not deliverable as addressed, unable to forward."
7. On July 1, 2013, a notice and copy of the certified complaint were sent to Kristina D. Frost, Clerk of the Supreme Court of Ohio requesting that the Clerk accept service on behalf of the respondent pursuant to Gov. Bar R. V, Section 11(B).
8. On July 3, 2013, the Board received a certification from Kristina D. Frost acknowledging receipt of the documents referenced in ¶7.

9. On July 5, 2013, a notice of intent to certify the respondent's default was sent to the respondent at the address in ¶3 and ¶4, her last known addresses.
10. On July 15, 2013, the notice referenced in ¶9 and sent to respondent's residence address in Campbell, Ohio was returned to the Board from the United States Postal Service and marked "return to sender, attempted-not known, unable to forward."
11. On July 22, 2013, the notice referenced in ¶9 and sent to respondent's address in West Palm Beach, Florida was returned to the Board from the United States Postal Service and marked "return to sender, not deliverable as addressed, unable to forward."
12. On July 23, 2013, the notice referenced in ¶9 was sent to Kristina D. Frost, Clerk of the Supreme Court of Ohio requesting that the Clerk accept service on behalf of the respondent pursuant to Gov. Bar R. V, Section 11(B).
13. On July 25, 2013, the Board received a certification from Kristina D. Frost acknowledging receipt of the documents referenced in ¶12.
14. As of the date of this affidavit, the respondent has not filed an answer to the formal complaint pending before the Board or otherwise responded to the certification of the complaint or the notice of intent to certify her default.
15. Attached to this affidavit are true and accurate copies of the following documents contained in the case file that is maintained in the Board offices:
 - a. The notice and formal complaint certified to the Board on June 10, 2013 and sent to the respondent at her address referenced in ¶3 and ¶4 via certified mail on that date;





Relator, Mahoning County Bar Association, states for its cause of action against
Respondent, Deneen Marrelli:

I. Parties

1. Relator is a local bar association which maintains a certified grievance committee pursuant to Gov. Bar R. V, Section 3.

2. Respondent is an attorney at law and is duly licensed to practice law in the State of Ohio.

3. Respondent's bar registration status with the Supreme Court of Ohio is "Active" and her bar registration number is 0043728.

4. Respondent's last known address is 5271 Stacy St. Apt. A, West Palm Beach, FL 33417-5818.

5. The Office of Attorney Services of the Supreme Court of Ohio lists Respondent's address as 46 Walter St., Campbell, Ohio 44405.

II. Factual Background

6. At all times relevant to this Complaint, Respondent was a solo practitioner whose office was located in Mahoning County in Campbell, Ohio.

7. Respondent also rented office space from the law office of Paris & Paris at 55 Public Square, Suite 1275 in Cuyahoga County in Cleveland, Ohio.

8. On or about July 20, 2010, Paul Robinson retained Respondent to represent him in a post-divorce matter regarding the custody of his two daughters. The relevant case is *Paul Robinson v. Jayne Robinson*, Division of Domestic Relations, Cuyahoga County Common Pleas Court, Case No. DR 312259.

9. Respondent did not provide a written fee agreement to Mr. Robinson that disclosed the identities of any other lawyers that may be working on his case.

10. Mr. Robinson paid \$2,000.00, by means of a Visa credit card in the name of his mother Nancy Lynn Robinson, to the Paris & Paris law firm for legal services to be performed by Respondent.

11. However, on July 20, 2010, Attorney John T. Paris filed a Notice of Appearance and a Motion for Continuance of a hearing scheduled for July 21, 2010 on behalf of Mr. Robinson even though Mr. Robinson did not retain Mr. Paris.

12. The Notice of Appearance and Motion for Continuance also bear the name of Respondent at the same address and phone number of Attorney John T. Paris and state that both John T. Paris and Respondent are "Attorneys for Plaintiff."

13. The Notice of Appearance further states that "[a]ll further court notices should be sent to Attorney John T. Paris at 55 Public Square, Suite 1275, Cleveland, Ohio 44113."

14. On July 21, 2010, Jayne Robinson, who was Mr. Robinson's ex-wife, through her counsel, filed a brief opposing the Motion for Continuance.

15. The July 21, 2010, hearing, did not go forward. The case was re-set for hearing on July 27, 2010.

16. On July 27, 2010, 6 days after hiring Respondent, Mr. Robinson terminated the services of Respondent and requested a refund of the unearned retainer.

17. On July 27, 2010, Respondent and Attorney John T. Paris filed a Motion to Withdraw as Mr. Robinson's counsel.

18. The Motion to Withdraw was apparently signed by both Respondent and Attorney John T. Paris at the same address and phone number. The Motion represents to the Court that both Respondent and Attorney John T. Paris are attorneys for Mr. Robinson.

19. The Motion to Withdraw was granted on July 29, 2010.

20. At the request of the investigator for the Mahoning County Bar Association, Respondent provided a "Statement" for services rendered to Paul Robinson.

21. The Statement reflects 15 hours of work billed at \$150.00 per hour for attorney work performed by Respondent, Attorney John Paris, and Attorney Thomas Paris.

22. Mr. Robinson was also billed at a rate of \$100.00 per hour for 3 hours of paralegal work.

23. The total bill on the Statement for representation that lasted 6 days was for \$2,200.00.

24. Attorneys John Paris and Thomas Paris admit that \$2,000.00 was paid to them by Nancy Lynn Robinson for legal services to be rendered by Respondent.

25. Attorneys John Paris and Thomas Paris state that, from the \$2,000.00, they paid \$900.00 to Respondent and they kept \$1,100.00 for monies owed to them by Respondent for rent and secretarial services.

26. Respondent has failed to cooperate in Relator's investigation in Mr. Robinson's case by failing to produce her client file on this matter, despite repeated requests.

27. U.S. mail sent to Respondent at the address she continues to maintain with the Office of Attorney Services of the Supreme Court of Ohio, i.e. 46 Walter St., Campbell, Ohio 44405, was returned as not deliverable and marked "Moved to Florida Not At this Address."

28. U.S. mail was also sent to Respondent on 3 occasions to the care of another individual at P.O. Box 7143, Lake Worth, FL 33466.

29. On the first occasion, the regular mail was not returned and the certified mail was signed for by the other individual.

30. On the second occasion, the regular mail was not returned but the certified mail was, after attempts to deliver it failed.

31. On the third occasion, the certified mail was unclaimed and marked Return to Sender but the regular mail was not returned.

32. On the same three occasions, U.S. mail, both regular and certified, was attempted at 5271 Stacy Ave., Apt. A, West Palm Beach, FL 33417-5818.

33. The first attempt, by certified mail, was received and signed for by Respondent.

34. On the second occasion, the certified mail was returned marked "Refuse." The regular mail was not returned.

35. On the third attempt, the certified mail was marked "Refuse" and "return to sender unclaimed." The regular mail was not returned.

III. Disciplinary Violations

36. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes violations of the following Rules of Professional Conduct:

- a. Rule 1.5(a) for charging a clearly excessive fee;
- b. Rule 1.5(e)(2) for failing to obtain the written consent of the client before dividing fees with lawyers outside of her firm;
- c. Rule 1.15(a) by failing to safeguard funds belonging to Mr. Robinson;


- d. Rule 8.1(b) by failing to cooperate in Relator's investigation;
- e. Rule 8.4(c) for failing to notify Mr. Robinson that she had engaged other lawyers to work on his case;
- f. Gov. Bar. V(4)(G) by failing to cooperate in Relator's investigation;
- g. Gov. Bar. R. VI(1)(D) for failing to keep the Office of Attorney Services apprised of her residence and office address.

WHEREFORE, Relator respectfully requests that Respondent be appropriately disciplined for her misconduct.
