

Claim Number 12-0077

This cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund this **6<sup>th</sup> day of September 2013** on the application of William Jackson alleging a loss in the amount of \$1,424, caused by dishonest conduct of an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of Ohio

The Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund of Ohio find that:

- a) An attorney client relationship did exist between the claimant and Gary Ray Axner.
- b) The claimant suffered a loss of \$1,424 on or about January, 2012.

The Commissioners further find that the dishonest conduct consisted of theft of unearned fees, and that the following disciplinary proceedings were taken:

**Suspended Indefinitely on 2/14/2013**

The Commissioners further find that the claimant took affirmative action against the attorney within one year of becoming aware of the loss; and that there is no insurance or bond which will benefit the claimant; and that said claimant is not a spouse, close relative, partner, insurer or bonding company, nor a governmental unit.

Therefore the Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund do hereby determine that the claim of William Jackson is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of \$1,424.

Payment of said amount is conditioned upon claimant complying with the subrogation assignment and other requirements of Sec. 6 of GOV. Rule VIII of the Ohio Supreme Court.

In Re Application of Sandra L. Woike and Philip Woike v. Gary Ray Axner  
Claim Number 12-0150

This cause came on for hearing before the Board of Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund this 6<sup>th</sup> day of September 2013 on the application of Sandra L. Woike and Philip Woike alleging a loss in the amount of \$599, caused by dishonest conduct of an attorney duly licensed to practice in the State of Ohio

The Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund of Ohio find that:

- a) An attorney client relationship did exist between the claimants and Gary Ray Axner.
- b) The claimants suffered a loss of \$973 on or about May, 2012.

The Commissioners further find that the dishonest conduct consisted of theft of unearned fees, and that the following disciplinary proceedings were taken:

**Suspended Indefinitely on 2/14/2013**

The Commissioners further find that the claimant took affirmative action against the attorney within one year of becoming aware of the loss; and that there is no insurance or bond which will benefit the claimant; and that said claimant is not a spouse, close relative, partner, insurer or bonding company, nor a governmental unit.

Therefore the Commissioners of the Clients' Security Fund do hereby determine that the claim of Sandra L. Woike is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of \$574, and Philip Woike is eligible for reimbursement in the amount of \$399.

Payment of said amount is conditioned upon claimant complying with the subrogation assignment and other requirements of Sec. 6 of GOV. Rule VIII of the Ohio Supreme Court.
