AGREED STIPULATION NUNC PRO TUNC – EXTENSION OF TIME

On December 26, 2013, following the December 23 filing of the final report of the Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline, this Court issued an *Order to Show Cause*. The Order specified that Mr. Cicero’s objections to the Board’s findings of fact, together with a merit brief, were due on or before 20 days from the Order date (or January 15, 2014).

On January 9, 2014, Mr. Cicero filed a motion for extension of time pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R 3.03(B)(2)(b)(i). Mr. Cicero and Disciplinary Counsel have since agreed, per S.Ct.Prac.R 3.03(B)(2)(a)(i), to a twenty-day extension of the deadline for Mr. Cicero to file his objections and merit brief. The parties agree that Mr. Cicero shall have until **February 4, 2014**, to file his objections and brief. To avoid confusion with Mr. Cicero’s earlier-filed motion, the parties respectfully request that this agreed stipulation be accepted in the place of that motion, nunc pro tunc.
