Re: *Columbus Bar Association v. Ray Jetmore King*, Case No. 2011-1418

Dear Mr. King:

On March 6, 2012, the court suspended you from the practice of law for a period of two years. The court further ordered that you could not apply for reinstatement until you filed proof with the court that you completed a minimum of 12 hours of continuing legal education related to accounting and law-practice management, in addition to the continuing legal education requirements of Gov.Bar R. X. On March 6, 2014, you filed an application for reinstatement. The Supreme Court of Ohio has informed the clerk's office that it will not consider an application for reinstatement until the attorney has complied with the court's orders and Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio.

The court's suspension order required you to comply with the CLE requirements for suspended attorneys as set forth in Gov.Bar R. X(3)(G). That rule required you to complete one credit hour of continuing legal education for each month, or portion of a month, of suspension. As part of those hours, you were required to complete one credit hour related to professional conduct for each six months, or portion of six months, of the suspension. Because you were suspended on March 6, 2012, when you filed your application for reinstatement on March 6, 2014, you needed to have completed a total of 24 hours of CLE, including four hours for instruction in professional conduct, in order to comply with Gov.Bar R. X(3)(G). Additionally, the court's order of March 6, 2012, also required you to complete a minimum of 12 CLE hours related to accounting and law-practice management, in addition to the hours required by Gov.Bar R. X. Thus, you are required to have completed a total of 36 CLE hours in order to be reinstated.



The attached letter and CLE transcript from the Office of Attorney Services indicates that since March 6, 2012, you have reported 30.0 CLE hours of which 7.0 hours were awarded for instruction in professional conduct. In addition, it does not appear that you have completed 12 CLE hours related to accounting and law-practice management.

If you believe the information provided by the Office of Attorney Services is inaccurate, please contact that office to resolve the matter. You may file additional documentation to support your compliance with this portion of the court's order. Note that all documents filed with the court in this case must meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio.
