Dear Mr. Deters:

Your "Motion for Reinstatement" in the above-referenced case was filed on March 28, 2014. A file-stamped copy of the motion and a copy of the docket are enclosed for your records. We were unable to file your affidavit of compliance, however, because it is untimely. As the enclosed copy of the court's January 27, 2014 order indicates, an affidavit showing compliance with the order was due in the clerk's office within thirty days of the date of the order. Therefore, your affidavit of compliance was due in the clerk's office on or before February 26, 2014.

The enclosed affidavit of compliance was received on March 28, 2014. Under Rule 3.02(D) of the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio, the clerk's office must refuse to file documents received after the filing deadline imposed by court order. Accordingly, your affidavit of compliance was not filed and is being returned.

If the court issues an order to show cause why you should not be held in contempt for failure to file an affidavit of compliance, you may resubmit the affidavit of compliance within the time provided by the show cause order. A separate response to a show cause order is optional.
