



Petitioner, The Lincoln Electric Company, in accordance with S.Ct.Prac.R. 17.09(B), submits this notice of a recent decision of the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit that reversed an Ohio federal district court ruling that Respondents cited in their merit brief and Petitioner cited in its reply brief. The relevant citation is: *IMG Worldwide, Inc. v. Westchester Fire Ins. Co.*, 6th Cir. Nos. 13-3832, 13-3837, 2014 WL 3409044 (decided July 15, 2014) (holding that excess insurer breached its duty to defend policyholder and was liable to pay nearly \$8 million in defense costs, after setting off only the amount that primary insurer paid in defense costs in a settlement with the policyholder).
