
Dear Mr. Rinderknecht:

On June 5, 2012, the Supreme Court of Ohio reinstated you to the practice of law and placed you on monitored probation for a period of two years. The court further ordered that at the end of the probationary period you may apply for termination of probation as provided in Gov.Bar R. V(9). It was further ordered that your probation shall not be terminated until (1) you file an application for termination of probation in compliance with Gov.Bar R. V(9)(D), (2) you comply with the reinstatement order and all other orders issued by this court, (3) you comply with the Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio, (4) relator files with the clerk of this court a report indicating that you have complied with the terms of the probation, and (5) this court orders that the probation be terminated.

On July 14, 2014, relator, Lorain County Bar Association, filed a motion to terminate probation. However, pursuant to Gov.Bar V(9)(D) and this court's reinstatement order you, and not relator, are required to file such a motion. Therefore, if you wish for your probation to be terminated at this time, please submit an application for termination of probation pursuant to Gov.Bar R. V(9)(D). In addition, please note that all documents filed with the court in this case must meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio.
