

**MOTION TO TAKE JUDICIAL NOTICE OF COURT ORDER, NOTICE OF  
VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL OF MOTION,  
AND NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE MOTION**

In accordance with Rule 201 of the Ohio Rules of Evidence, Relator-Father Aristides Jurado acting Pro Se, and Relator-Minor Child N.G., through his father Relator Aristides Jurado, request that this Honorable Court take **judicial notice of the Court Order issued by Respondent** Honorable Terri Jamison, "The Juvenile Court", issued and filed on July 23, 2014. On its own cognition, the Juvenile Court ordered a general Stay pending the outcome of this original action. An authenticated and redacted copy of the Entry has been included in Exhibit J6. This latest Order by Respondent the Juvenile Court renders moot Relator's Motion for Emergency Stay of Proceedings filed on July 22, 2014, which was combined with a Motion for Expedited Issuance of Alternative Writ of Prohibition. Therefore, pursuant to Ohio Civil rule 41(A), **Relators voluntarily dismiss their Motion for Emergency Stay of Proceedings** filed on July 22, 2014.

In direct connection with Relators' Motion for Expedited Issuance of Alternative Writ of Prohibition, which is still pending adjudication, **Relators hereby file a Notice of Intent to File Motion for Expedited Issuance of Peremptory Writ or Alternative Writ of Mandamus** with Combined Memorandum in Support and to Supplement the pending Motion for Expedited Issuance of Alternative Writ of Prohibition filed on July 22, 2014.
