

APPLICATION FOR REINSTATEMENT  
TO THE PRACTICE OF LAW

MOTION

Now comes Respondent, Carole (Hutchins) Squire, to request leave of the Court to file an **Application for Reinstatement to the Practice of Law** prior to full payment of court costs ordered in Ohio Supreme Court Case No. 2007-492; for court cost associated with Ohio Supreme Court Disciplinary Case No. 05-087.

AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF MOTION


- 1) On October 25, 2007, this Court suspended Respondent from the practice of law for two years with one year stayed on the condition Respondent have no violations of any disciplinary rules or regulations governing attorneys or judges in the state of Ohio. Respondent has met the aforementioned condition.
- 2) On November 21, 2007, Respondent filed an Affidavit of Compliance with this Court indicating compliance with all aspects of the relevant order from this Court.
- 3) I have completed 89.5 hours of continuing legal education as required , including 14 hours of Professional Conduct continuing legal education.
- 4) Notwithstanding family medical emergencies, including Respondent's emergency eye surgeries, and suspension of Respondent's license to practice law, preventing work in the area of Respondent's experience gained during a 30- year legal career, Respondent has paid \$7,000 (monthly credit card payments continue to date to satisfy this \$7,000 payment) of Court Cost ordered by the Ohio Supreme Court; court cost assessed in Case No. 05-087; costs

associated with Respondent's disciplinary hearings, convened days during Aug-Oct 2006, Before the Ohio Supreme Court Board of Commissioners on Grievances and Discipline .

5) Due, in part, to multiple family medical emergencies since Respondent's suspension, and a continued need to give attention to and to respond to family medical needs and treatment for chronic conditions and to assist with care, Respondent hereby requests leave of the Court to file **Application for Reinstatement to the Practice of Law**, prior to full payment of the subject court ordered court cost. Reinstatement to the practice of law would allow Respondent to greatly expedite payment of the subject court ordered costs, in part due to the flexible work hours a license to practice law allows in Respondent's area of former legal practice ; i.e. legal service to abused, neglected, and dependent children.

For the foregoing reasons, Respondent respectfully requests that the Ohio Supreme Court grant Respondent's **Motion for Leave of Court to File Application for Reinstatement to the Practice of Law**, prior to full payment of all of the subject court ordered court costs, as the Ohio Supreme Court has permitted and ordered in other disciplinary cases concerning attorneys other than Respondent; cases in which the Ohio Supreme Court has allowed reinstatement to the practice of law of other attorneys prior to full payment of court ordered costs; payments permitted to be made as lawyers generate income while engaged in the practice of law, thereby assisting in payment of court fees and costs. **Further Affiant Sayeth Naught.**


