Dear Mr. Kraemer:

On July 22, 2010, you were suspended from the practice of law for a period of two years, with one year stayed on conditions and with credit for one year served under your interim suspension. On September 2, 2010, you were reinstated to the practice of law and placed on a two-year monitored probation. The court ordered relator to file a report at the end of your probationary period stating whether you complied with the conditions of probation and monitoring.

On December 1, 2014, you filed an Application for Termination of Probation. The Supreme Court of Ohio has informed the clerk's office that it will not consider an attorney's application for termination of probation until the court's orders and Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio have been fully complied with and the requirements for termination of probation have been met. Although relator filed a notice of appointment of monitoring attorney on September 10, 2010, as of the date of this letter, relator has not filed its report with the court. The court will not consider your termination of probation until such time as relator files this report with the clerk's office of the Supreme Court.

In addition, Gov.Bar R.V(9)(D) provides that an application for termination of probation shall be accompanied by an affidavit executed by the respondent. Your application for termination of probation filed on December 1, 2014, was not accompanied by the affidavit required by Gov.Bar R.V(9)(D). You may file additional documentation to support your compliance with Gov.Bar R.V(9)(D). Note that all documents filed with the court in this case must meet the filing requirements set forth in the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio.
