**JOINT MOTION TO RE-REFER TO MEDIATION OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE,
TO STAY ALL FILING DEADLINES AND ACTIONS DUE TO A TENTATIVE
SETTLEMENT**

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Appellants, with the authorization of and on behalf of counsel for all of the other parties to the above-captioned action, hereby move that this case be re-referred to mediation pursuant to S.Ct. Prac.R. 4.02 and 19.01(A) or, in the alternative, that all filing deadlines and actions by this Court on pending motions be stayed until further notice due to a tentative settlement. We hereby notify the Court that counsel for the parties hereto have reached a tentative settlement, subject to minor language changes still under discussion and subject to formal approval by the principles. In the case of the Board of Education, final approval requires action by the Board at a public meeting, which counsel for the Board anticipates will be considered at either the March 3 or March 17, 2015 regular Board meeting. Final approval by the other principles is anticipated before action by the Board in March. Re-referral to mediation with its attendant stay, or the stay requested in the alternative, will facilitate a prompt voluntary resolution of this case by the parties without the need for this Court to rule on other pending motions or on the merits of the case.
