
Dear Ms. Christoff:

Sterling Everard Gill (Attorney Registration No. 0034021) filed an Application for Reinstatement with this court on March 11, 2015, pursuant to Gov.Bar R. V(24)(A). According to the court's order dated October 24, 2013, Mr. Gill was suspended from the practice of law for a period of two years with the second year stayed on conditions. The court further ordered that in applying for reinstatement Mr. Gill must prove that he has completed 12 hours of continuing legal education on law-office management in addition to the requirements of Gov.Bar R. X(3)(G), at least six hours of which shall be focused on the proper use and maintenance of his trust account.

As noted above, the court's order directed the respondent to comply with the continuing legal education requirements of Gov.Bar R. X(3)(G). Could you please inform me whether Mr. Gill has received any credit for continuing legal education hours since October 24, 2013? Please provide the course descriptions for any seminar completed. I would appreciate it if you would also inform me if any of the CLE hours related to professional conduct. Finally, please confirm whether Mr. Gill is in compliance with all other provisions of Rule X.
