Respondent's Application for Reinstatement

Now comes Eric D. Hall by and through Counsel, Alexander R. Folk, who respectfully requests reinstatement to the practice of law.

On March 1, 2012, this Court issued a decision captioned **Disciplinary Counsel v. Hall**, 131 Ohio St.3d 222, 2012-Ohio-783. The decision suspended Mr. Hall for a period of 24 months with six months stayed followed by one year of probation. The Court conditioned reinstatement on the payment of restitution to a number of clients, payment of costs and any additional fees and terms imposed by rule.

Pursuant to that Order and the rules for reinstatement, Mr. Hall presents that he is eligible for reinstatement.

Mr. Hall has no pending disciplinary matters.

Mr. Hall did not face any criminal charges and therefore had no term of probation, etc.

Mr. Hall has fully complied with and completed his continuing legal education requirements as provided by Gov. Bar R. X. (See attached Exhibits of CLE credits not yet reported on the official transcript)

Mr. Hall completed the entire 24 month suspension.

Mr. Hall has fully paid the cost of the proceedings.

Mr. Hall has made full payment to the named persons in the March 1, 2012 decision.

Mr. Hall has made full payment to the Lawyer's Fund for Client Protection.

Mr. Hall has paid his reinstatement fees and current biennium dues.

Mr. Hall is prepared to begin his one-year probationary period and comply with those terms and conditions imposed under Gov. Bar R. V, Section 21.




