Dear Mr. Trivers:

On September 15, 2014, you were reinstated to the practice of law and placed on probation for a period of one year in both of the above-captioned matters. The court ordered relator to file a report at the end of your probationary period stating whether you complied with the conditions of probation and monitoring.

On October 13, 2015, you filed an Application for Termination of Probation. The Supreme Court of Ohio has informed the clerk's office that it will not consider an attorney's application for termination of probation until the court's orders and Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio have been fully complied with and the requirements for termination of probation have been met. Although relator filed a notice of appointment of monitoring attorney on October 10, 2014, as of the date of this letter, relator has not filed its report with the court. The court will not consider your termination of probation until such time as relator files this report with the clerk's office of the Supreme Court.
