OPPOSITION TO RECONSIDERATION


Appellee State of Ohio opposes Dean's motion for reconsideration. Dean offers nothing but reargument of contentions already raised in his briefs and rejected by the Court. Mere reargument is not permitted under S. Ct. Prac. R. 18.02, and this Court should deny Dean's motion for reconsideration for that reason alone.

Relative to the weighing process, Dean merely re-argues that his mitigation warrants a life sentence. Relative to the sufficiency and manifest weight of the evidence claims, Dean merely re-argues that every witness who testified against him lacks credibility. Relative to transferred intent claim, Dean merely disagrees with the Court in its findings that "The victims at the Mini Mart and the drive-by shooting are also readily identified." *State v. Dean*, Slip Opinion No. 2015 Ohio 4347, P 145. None of Dean's arguments warrant reconsideration.


