

has complied with the terms and conditions of her probation during the probationary period; (3) respondent complies with the Supreme Court's disciplinary order and all orders issued by the Court; (4) respondent complies with the Rules for the Government of the Bar of Ohio; and (5) this Court issues an order terminating respondent's probation.

Now comes relator, Disciplinary Counsel, and submits the following report regarding respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of her probation.

**RELATOR'S REPORT RE RESPONDENT'S
COMPLIANCE WITH PROBATION**

Pursuant to this Court's February 10, 2015 order, relator supervised respondent's one-year probation. Under Gov. Bar R. V(21), relator appointed Robert J. Christian, Esq. to monitor respondent's law practice, including her law-office management and trust-account management. Mr. Christian was also directed, as part of his duties as probation monitor, to submit periodic written reports to relator regarding respondent's progress on probation.


Each of the periodic reports submitted by Probation Monitor Christian reflected that respondent was performing well on probation and that she was in full compliance with the terms of her probation. At no time during respondent's one-year probation did relator receive a report, either from Mr. Christian or from any other source, demonstrating or alleging that respondent had violated the terms of her probation. Moreover, in his final probation report, dated February 5, 2016, Probation Monitor Christian concluded that "I believe that Attorney Gorby has complied with the terms and conditions of her probation."

Based upon relator's review of the Probation Monitor's detailed periodic written reports, relator concludes that Probation Monitor Christian was in substantial compliance with his monitoring duties under Gov. Bar R. V(21).

Relator further concludes that respondent has fully complied with the terms of her probation, that she has been cooperative with Probation Monitor Christian throughout the probationary period, that she has properly maintained her IOLTA account and that she has been practicing law in a competent manner.

Therefore, upon the submission of this Report, relator respectfully submits that this Court may now consider any application that respondent may file to terminate her probation.
