
## State of Ohio v. Jeffrey A. Wogenstahl

You are hereby ORDERED, pursuant to Rule 15.03, of the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio, to prepare and forward the record in the above-captioned case to the Clerk's Office of the Supreme Court, within 20 days of the date of this entry:

Pursuant to Rule 15.01 the record shall consist of the following:
