RELATORS' REQUEST FOR EVIDENTIARY HEARING

Relators, The Ohio Manufacturers' Association, The Ohio Chamber of Commerce, Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America, Keith Lake, and Ryan R. Augsburger (collectively "Relators") hereby submit their response to the Court's order of May 18, 2016, stating that "any request for an evidentiary hearing, if necessary, shall be made within 14 days of this entry."

At this time, Relators request an evidentiary hearing. But, given the status of discovery (as set forth in the Joint Report on the Status of Discovery filed on June 1, 2016) and previous filings in this action, Relators do not know whether it will be necessary to have an evidentiary hearing. Relators will not know for certain whether they need an evidentiary hearing until outstanding discovery is completed. Since the out-of-state depositions have not yet occurred (but most have been scheduled), it is difficult to know whether an evidentiary hearing will be necessary. As a result, Relators make this request with the caveat that the request for an evidentiary hearing may be withdrawn in light of additional discovery that has been sought, but not yet completed.
