Now comes the Respondent, Edwin L. Vardiman Jr., Ohio Reg. Attorney No. 0070574 of 122 Highland Ave., Ft. Thomas, Ky 41075 and hereon respectfully makes his Motion for Reinstatement to the practice of Law in the State of Ohio.

On February 3, 2016 this Court issued its ORDER suspending myself from the practice of law for the period of one [1] year with six [6] months stayed on conditions.

The Respondent asserts to the honorable Court that the Conditions of the six month suspension as set out by the February 3, 2016 Order have been adhered to and satisfied in full and total by Respondent.

To wit, Respondent was Ordered and has complied with:

(1) Comply with the terms of his Ohio Lawyers Assistance Program Contact. As attached to this Motion, Scott R. Mote, Esq., Executive Director of OLAP states in his July 21, 2016 letter that he is verifying that I am in compliance with my three-year OLPA Mental Health Contract, signed April 30, 2014.

(2) Maintain appropriate medical and psychological treatment. I have maintained my treatment by my primary Physician Amy S. Haney, MD of St. Elizabeth Physicians Group, Hebron Ky. and have adhered to taking all medications as prescribed by her to assist in my

management of ADD. Further, as attached to this Motion my psychologist, Todd F. Walker, Psy.D, certifies in his letter of July 28, 2016 that I have properly continued with my treatment sessions with him and complied with all of his directives regarding successful management of my ADD in personal and professional settings.

(3) Submit quarterly reports documenting his/[my] compliance with the foregoing obligations to a monitoring attorney selected by realtors. As of this date I have not received any correspondence or directives from either the Cincinnati Bar Association or the Warren County Bar Association regarding this condition. I have kept both Realtors correctly informed of my location and all contact points during the time of my suspension.

(4) Engage in no further misconduct. I hereby certify that I have faithfully adhered to all tenants of the Order of Suspension as set in my Affidavit of Compliance filed with this Court on March 1, 2016 and have had no further incidents of misconduct.


