VI. "Criminal Justice Reform" Legislative Efforts

The Committee will discuss recently introduced and/or draft legislation – i.e. Senator Eklund's bill draft.

Transitional Control Administrative Rules

<u>HB 30:</u> To amend sections 2929.01, 2929.13, and 2929.14 and to enact section 2941.1425 of the Revised Code to require an additional prison term of 3 to 8 years for an offender who is convicted of or pleads guilty to a felony offense of violence if the offender is convicted of or pleads guilty to a specification that the victim suffered permanent disabling harm and that the victim was under 6 years of age at the time of the offense.

<u>HB38</u>: To amend sections 2903.01, 2903.11, and 2929.14 of the Revised Code to provide that purposely causing the death of a first responder or military member is aggravated murder and to require an offender to serve the prison term imposed for felonious assault on a peace officer, investigator, first responder, or military member consecutively to the prison term imposed for any related offense.

<u>HB4:</u> To amend sections 2925.03 and 2925.11 of the Revised Code to provide that in determining the amount of cocaine for trafficking and possession offenses, it also includes a compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing cocaine, and to declare an emergency.
