

SUPREME COURT
CHIEF JUSTICE AND SIX JUSTICES
Original jurisdiction in select cases; court of last resort on state constitutional questions and questions of public or great general interest; appeals from Board of Tax Appeals, Public Utilities Commission and death penalty cases.

COURT OF APPEALS
TWELVE DISTRICTS, THREE-JUDGE PANELS
Appellate review of judgments of common pleas, municipal and county courts; appeals from Board of Tax Appeals; original jurisdiction in select cases.

COURTS OF COMMON PLEAS
IN EACH OF 88 COUNTIES

GENERAL DIVISION Civil and criminal cases; appeals from most administrative agencies.	DOMESTIC RELATIONS DIVISION Divorces and dissolutions; support and custody of children	JUVENILE DIVISION Offenses involving minors; most paternity actions.	PROBATE DIVISION Decedents' estates; mental illness; adoptions; marriage licenses.

MUNICIPAL AND COUNTY COURTS
Misdemeanor offenses; traffic cases; civil action up to \$15,000.

COURT OF CLAIMS
JUDGES ASSIGNED BY THE CHIEF JUSTICE
All suits against the state for personal injury, property damage, contract and wrongful death; compensation for victims of crime. Three-judge panels upon request.

MAYOR'S COURTS
Not courts of record.
Violations of local ordinances and state traffic laws. Matters can be reheard in municipal or county courts.
