



CASES BY CATEGORY




Caseload 2013-2017

CASES FILED 2013-2017





CASES PENDING ON THE 31ST DAY OF DECEMBER 2013-2017








Time to Disposition 2013-2017















Briefing to Oral Argument 2013-2017


ALL CASES ARGUED⁴ From Completion of Briefing to Oral Argument




