



## IN THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS 'HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO

This matter came before the court on December 30, 2024, where the Court found that Defendant, Kristal Ilboudo, was a vexatious litigator as defined in § 2323.52 (A)(3). As to litigation concerning the State of Ohio and Hamilton County as a vexatious litigator the Defendant, Kristal Ilboudo, has been prohibited by this Court pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 2323.52(D)(1)(a)-(c) from doing one or more of the following without first obtaining the leave of that court to proceed:

- a) Instituting legal proceeding in the court of claims or in a court of common pleas, municipal court or county court, involving the State of Ohio or Hamilton County;
- b) Continuing any legal proceedings that the vexatious litigator had instituted in any of the courts specified in division (D)(1)(a) of this section prior to the entry of the order;
- c) Making any application, other than an application for leave to proceed under division (F)(1) of this section, in any legal proceedings involving the State of Ohio or Hamilton County instated by the vexatious litigator or another person in any of the courts specified in division (D)(1)(a) of this section.



It is the further order of the Court that the Order finding Defendant Kristal Ilboudo to be a vexatious litigator <u>will be effective for three (3) years or unless the Court declares otherwise</u>. Any violation of this Order may result in a contempt finding against the Defendant.

The Clerk of Court shall send a certified copy of this order to the Supreme Court of Ohio for publication.
