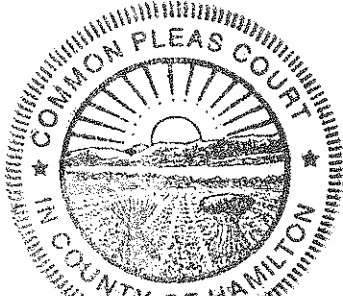

This matter came before the Court on Municipal Court Judge Melissa A. Powers' referral and Defendant/Judgment Debtor T-Mobile USA, Inc.'s ("T-Mobile") Motion to Declare Plaintiff/Judgment Creditor Darlington Amadasu ("Plaintiff") a Harassing and Vexatious Litigator ("Motion") pursuant to O.R.C. § 2323.52. Having considered the Municipal Court Judge's referral, T-Mobile's Motion, the arguments of the parties, and being otherwise sufficiently advised, it is hereby ORDERED that Plaintiff shall be considered a vexatious litigator, and as a consequence, it is the ORDER of this Court that Plaintiff shall be prohibited from the following: (1) instituting legal proceedings in the court of common pleas, municipal court, or county court; (2) continuing any legal proceedings that Plaintiff has instituted in any of the courts specified above prior to this order; and (3) making any application, other than an application for leave to proceed under O.R.C. § 2323.52(F)(1), in any legal proceedings instituted by Plaintiff or another person in any of the courts specified above. To be clear, the provisions of O.R.C. § 2323.52(D)(3) regarding appeals, and all other restrictions on initiating or continuing any litigation in O.R.C. § 2323.52, apply to Plaintiff. Should Plaintiff wish to

institute new litigation or continue existing litigation in any Ohio court, he must obtain leave from the presiding judge of the appropriate court.
