## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

**2002-0506. State v. Fitzpatrick.**

Hamilton C.P. No. B0104117. On joint motion to vacate execution date. Motion granted. Execution date scheduled for April 16, 2026, vacated.

## MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

**2024-0073. U.S. Flue-Cured Tobacco Growers, Inc. v. Yost.**

In Mandamus. On relator's application for dismissal. Application granted. Cause dismissed.

**2024-0301. State ex rel. Doogs v. Dept. of Rehab. & Corr.**

In Mandamus. Relator has not filed a merit brief, due June 21, 2024, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

**2024-0376. Keith v. Franklin Cty. Prosecutor's Office.**

In Mandamus. Relator has not filed a merit brief, due June 21, 2024, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

**2024-0766. NewRez, L.L.C. v. Chapman.**

Stark App. No. 2023 CA 00135. Appellant has not filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction, due June 17, 2024, in compliance with the Rules of Practice of the Supreme Court of Ohio and therefore has failed to prosecute this cause with the requisite diligence. Cause dismissed.

**2024-0881. State ex rel. Tjaden v. Geauga Cty. Bd. of Elections.**

In Mandamus. On relator's application for dismissal of respondents Secretary of State Frank LaRose and Attorney General Dave Yost. Application granted. This cause remains pending on the claims against the remaining respondents.

## **MEDIATION MATTERS**

**2024-0203. State ex rel. Castellon v. O'Malley.**

In Mandamus. The court returns this case to the regular docket under S.Ct.Prac.R. 19.01. Respondents shall file a response to the complaint within 21 days.

**2024-0895. Claugus Family Farm, L.P. v. Harris.**

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 2020-740. The court refers this case to mediation under S.Ct.Prac.R. 19.01 and stays all filing deadlines for this case until further order of this court. The court will not issue any decision on the merits in this case until mediation has concluded.
