## MERIT DECISIONS WITHOUT OPINIONS

### **2024-0881. State ex rel. Tjaden v. Geauga Cty. Bd. of Elections.**

In Mandamus. On respondent Ashtabula County Board of Elections' motion to dismiss. Motion granted based on the jurisdictional-priority rule. Sua sponte, cause dismissed as to respondent Geauga County Board of Elections based on the jurisdictional-priority rule. Respondent Geauga County Board of Elections' motion to dismiss denied as moot. Relator's motion for expedited hearing schedule denied as moot. Cause dismissed.

Kennedy, C.J., and DeWine, Donnelly, Brunner, and Deters, JJ., concur.

Fischer and Stewart, JJ., dissent and would deny respondent Ashtabula County Board of Elections' motion to dismiss, grant in part and deny in part respondent Geauga County Board of Elections' motion to dismiss, and grant relator's motion for expedited hearing schedule.
