## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

## 2024-1041. State ex rel. Tjaden v. Geauga Cty. Bd. of Elections.

In Mandamus. On respondents' joint motion to dismiss. Motion denied. Relator's motion for expedited hearing schedule granted. Sua sponte, alternative writ granted. The following schedule is set for presentation of evidence and filing of briefs pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 12.05: Respondents shall file their answer to the complaint within three days of the court's entry; relator shall file his evidence and merit brief within seven days of the filing of the answer or, if no answer is filed, within seven days of the date the answer was due; respondents shall file their evidence and merit brief within seven days of the filing of relator's merit brief; and relator may file a reply brief within three days of the filing of respondents' merit brief. All filings are due by 4:00 p.m. on the date they are due to be filed. No requests or stipulations for extension of time shall be filed, and the clerk of the court shall refuse to file any requests or stipulations for extension of time.
